This resource has been developed to help K-2 teachers extend the use of **Lulu and Boo** in their classrooms.



**Bob appears at Lulu and Boo's window and tempts them outside for the first time.**

Imagine you are Lulu or Boo going outside for the first time ever. What do you see? What do you smell? What do you hear?



**House cats and bobcats both belong to the Felidae family. Use books and the Internet to compare and contrast house cats and bobcats.**

How big are they? What do they eat? Where do they live?



**Lulu and Boo think the outdoors are scary, but then realize they are a lot of fun! Share something you were once scared to try, but are now happy you did.**



**Purchase Lulu and Boo stuffies from [AnnieBCompany.com/Shop](http://AnnieBCompany.com/Shop) or use any cat stuffies to represent Lulu and Boo. Send the cats home with each student for a night. Ask each student to take a photograph or draw a picture of Lulu and Boo enjoying the night at their house. Have them write a paragraph about what they did together.**

Once every student has had a turn with the cats, gather the photographs/drawings and stories to create your very own Lulu and Boo book.



**House cats have four sensitive paws, 20 sharp claws, and a long tail to help them balance. Get on all fours and perfect your cat walk.**
